### MISSION STATEMENT

St. Joseph University Parish is a Catholic community proclaiming the Gospel of Jesus Christ by living it through worship, prayer, faith formation and service.

Dear Parishioners,

The Second Sunday of Easter always includes the gospel account of the Apostle Thomas who was not present at the first appearance of the risen Jesus to his gathered disciples. When he is told that they had seen the risen Lord he doubts and says that he has to see the Lord and probe his wounds for himself. (Thus, we have the term "doubting Thomas" for all who are slow to believe.) Thomas' first mistake was withdrawing from the other disciples and letting the anguish of the crucifixion get the best of him. He chose to face it alone. Secondly, he was unwilling to accept the experience of others as enough of a witness to bring him to belief.

Of course, these mistakes are the same ones we can make. We can choose to face our perils alone and we can choose not to listen to the witness of others to strengthen our faith. The truth of the matter is that we need one another especially when trying times come our way. We strengthen each other when our own strength is waning. It is also the faith of others that can carry us through our times of doubt. Ultimately, though, each of us will need the experience of God in our lives, our own encounter with Jesus, to experience the new life of the resurrection that Jesus offers us. This experience comes to us in community and in our own prayer.
