The gospel for the Second Sunday of Lent is always an account of the transfiguration of Jesus on the mountain. Jesus goes up the mountain to pray and there is met by Moses and Elijah, and they "spoke of his exodus that he was going to accomplish in Jerusalem." They are praying on the mountain but they are considering the affairs of earth. Even though Peter wants to build three tents and stay there, he finds out that prayer on the mountain is preparation for action on earth. In the passage on the mountain, Jesus led his followers back to their everyday affairs, enlightened by what they had experienced.

They still had to go through challenging and difficult times before they could come to the glory they had seen, and so do we. On the mountain the disciples heard the voice of the God the Father say: "This is my chosen Son; listen to him." By continually listening to Jesus in prayer we will be able to find our way on earth. The vision of who Jesus is and what he calls us to be gives us hope in our more difficult times to be faithful to God who has made us for the fullness of life.

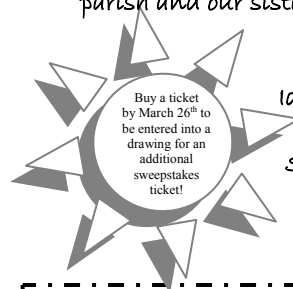
