MISSION STATEMENT

St. Joseph University Parish is a Catholic community proclaiming the Gospel of Jesus Christ by living it through worship, prayer, faith formation and service.

Dear Parishioners,

God calls people to change their way of life to something beyond what they are doing at the present. This can be seen in all three of this weekend's readings. Isaiah was called from the position of high priest to be a prophet; Peter was called from the life of a fisherman to be a fisher of people; and Paul was called from being a persecutor of the early Christian church to be one who proclaimed the gospel of Jesus Christ. In calling people to something new God is not necessarily suggesting that the previous way of life was bad or unworthy (although that could be true). Rather, God calls people to walk closer in the footsteps of Jesus, his Son.

The call to more closely imitate the love of Christ comes to all Christians. It doesn't usually mean that we have to leave home and everything we have and become a missionary like Isaiah, Paul or Peter. Rather, it is a call to greater love and service of others, a call that may require a change in the way we spend our time, in how we view our priorities, and how we think about and act toward others. If we accept this call we will find that the grace of God gives us the strength and ability to do what God asks of us.
