Dear Parishioners,

In this Sunday's first reading we hear Moses tell us that God's command is not too mysterious or remote for us, "No, it is something very near to you, already in your mouths and in your hearts; you have only to carry it out." Then, in the Gospel a scholar of the law tests Jesus by asking him what he must do to enter eternal life. When Jesus asked him what the law says the lawyer knew the response already--that one needed to love God, and to love neighbor as oneself. Because the lawyer wanted to justify himself he asked Jesus, "And who is my neighbor?" Jesus then told the story about the good Samaritan and the lawyer knew for himself who was a neighbor to the fallen man.

Many of us are like the lawyer insofar as we have a difficulty connecting our religious faith to the rest of our lives. There are times that we may well know what is the best thing to do and yet do not do it, finding a way to justify our inaction. Human compassion is already in our mouths and hearts and we need to make the step to carry it out in service to one another.

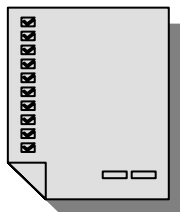

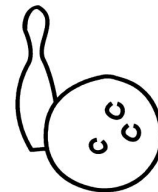
