**MISSION STATEMENT**

St. Joseph University Parish is a Catholic community proclaiming the Gospel of Jesus Christ by living it through worship, prayer, faith formation and service.

Dear Parishioners,

In this Sunday's gospel Jesus asks his disciples: "Who do you say that I am?" Our answer to that question sets the course for our lives. If Jesus is for us like he was for the early disciples, the "Christ of God," then how we live our lives will be centered on the example he set for us. He is one who dedicated his life to serving others, showing compassion and striving for reconciliation and peace. He reached out to all people--especially the outcast, the burdened and the sinner--and he offered them hope and the blessing of the good news of God's love.

His message was not received well by all people, however, and we know that they crucified him for it. Knowing where his life was leading him he warned his early followers of the need to prepare themselves to "take up his cross daily and follow" him. This cross is not the normal pains and trials of life but embodies what would happen if we live our lives with daily steadfast loyalty to Jesus and his way of life. If we live out the values he gave us we too will pay a price for it because our values will be tested by the society around us. So we answer the question of who we say Jesus is to us by how faithfully we live according to his Good News.
