### MISSION STATEMENT

St. Joseph University Parish is a Catholic community proclaiming the Gospel of Jesus Christ by living it through worship, prayer, faith formation and service.

Dear Parishioners,

Everyone needs to eat, and if we don't eat we get hungry. The physical hunger of the crowd that had gathered around Jesus in a deserted place and who had no food is described in the Gospel today. The disciples suggested to Jesus that he dismiss the crowd so that they could find food, but Jesus told the disciples to give them some food themselves. When they replied that they had just a little food Jesus took what little they had and turned it into abundance for all.

We all have more than just physical hunger, however. The crowd gathered around Jesus in a deserted place because they hungered for something more than food: they hungered for the word he spoke, and the healing he offered, they hungered for more in life. Jesus himself satisfies that hunger by his presence, his word and his own flesh under the form of bread and wine in the Eucharist. He gives his Body and Blood to us to satisfy our deeper hunger and then says to us as he said to his disciples: give others something to eat yourselves, share with others what you have received.
