Dear Parishioners,

There is plenty that happens that can upset our peace of mind, and one of those things is change. In the first reading from the Acts of the Apostles the early Christians were dealing with changing what was required to be a follower of Christ. Would the non-Jewish converts have to follow the Jewish laws or not? This possible change caused a great deal of disturbance in the early community. For us, too, the thought of changing from what is familiar and comfortable to something unknown makes us upset and fearful. We know we run the risk of being in a new situation where we can lose what we know and value, that we could be worse off than what we are now, that we might be lost in strange territory.

The words of Jesus we hear this weekend are welcome words indeed: "Peace I leave with you; my peace I give to you. Not as the world gives do I give it to you. Do not let your hearts be troubled or afraid." The peace of the world comes and goes. It is dependent on outer circumstances. The peace of Christ comes from a deep faith that nothing can separate us from the love of God. It doesn't solve our problems but gives us the confidence to deal with them more effectively.
