Despite the challenges of life in El Salvador, Fernando dreams of becoming a businessman. His desire for a better future for his family motivates him to sell cookbooks on San Salvador's buses for \$10 a day, despite the danger from the gangs that stop and harass drivers and passengers. His dreams led him to YouthBuild, a six-month, CRS-sponsored program that trains young people in business. Training for six months with YouthBuild wasn't easy on Fernando or his family. Without his wife to support him and care for their two young children, the early mornings and long days might have been impossible. He is putting his newfound skills to work. After graduating from YouthBuild, he participated in a series of entrepreneur workshops organized by CRS and is currently working on a new business plan. And, now he mentors other young people.
