Spotlight on Lectors

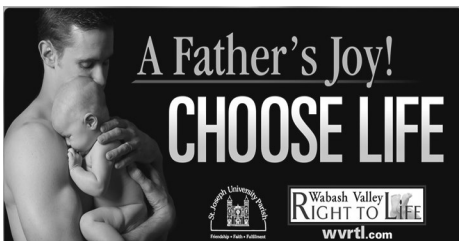

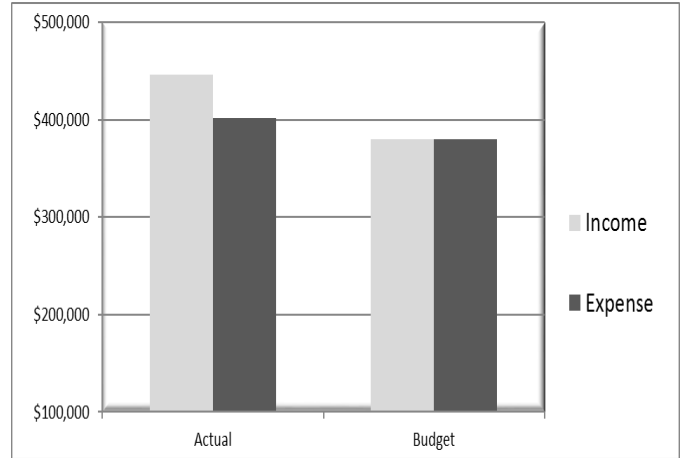

Income for the last six months of 2016 was \$52,000 more than budgeted. Holy day offerings were \$ 8,435 which was \$5,335 more than budgeted. Donations were \$ 53,014 which was \$ 33,014 more than budgeted; of those donations, \$ 55,341 were received in the month of December. Sunday offering was \$ 15,687 less than the anticipated budget amount.

Expenses for the last six months of 2016 were \$22,540 more than budgeted. Maintenance expenses include \$ 3,015 for a boiler repair.
