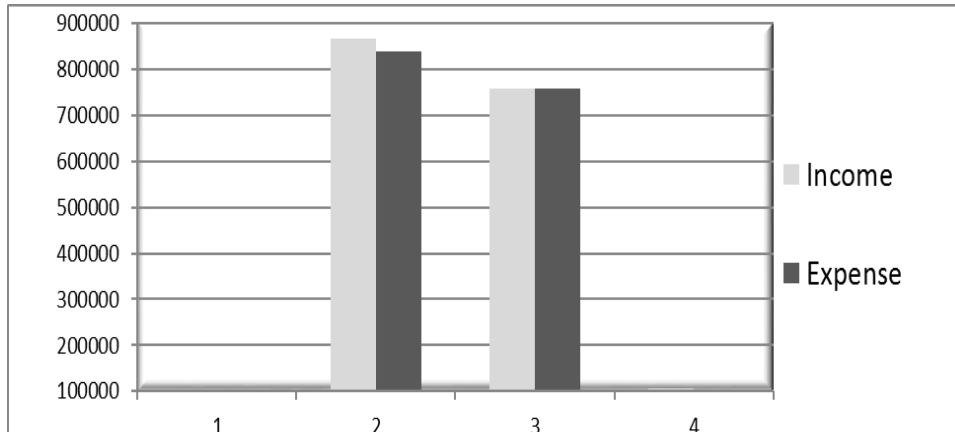
Just a quick reminder **Sunday, August 6 is Samaritan Sunday**. The pantry is requesting donations of toilet paper. Thank you for your generosity!
